Autor „Halal standarda Srbije“ (Beograd, 2009, HSS-2009); te autor više stručnih članaka iz oblasti halal-standardizacije na engleskom i arapskom jeziku (predavanja i referati u Kuala-Lumpuru, Antaliji, Briselu, ...); predavač na edukativno-informativnim halal-seminarima (Leskovac, Niš, Kragujevac, Beograd, Sjenica, Novi Sad, Kikinda, Zrenjanin, ...); stručni konsultant u izradi više master-radova i doktorskih disertacija iz oblasti ekonomije za pitanja halal-standarda; radi kao direktor sertifikacije Halal-agencije Islamske zajednice Srbije (pored sertifikacije, Halal agencija organizuje i sprovodi halal protokol za Republiku Srbiju, poput Univerzijade 2009) i predstavnik je Srbije (status posmatrača) u Evropskom komitetu za standardizaciju halal-hrane Evrope (formalni status posmatrača, faktički glavni konsultant izradi halal-standarda EU). Author of "Halal standard of Serbia" (Belgrade, 2009, HSS-2009) and the author of several noncommercial articles on halal standardization in English and Arabic (lectures and papers in Kuala Lumpur, Antalya, Brussels ...); lecturer in an educational and informative halal seminars (Leskovac, Niš, Kragujevac, Belgrade, Sjenica, Novi Sad, Kikinda, Zrenjanin, ...), a consultant in the preparation of several master's theses and doctoral dissertations in economics for questions regarding halal standards and marketing; he works as certification manager in Halal Agency of The Islamic Community of Serbia (in addition to certification, Halal agency organizes and conducts halal protocol for the Republic of Serbia, such as the Universiade 2009) and is representative of Serbia (observer status) in the European Committee for Standardization halal food of Europe (formal observer status, in fact, one of the main consultants for EU halal standards).
